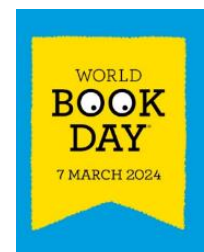
The top three classes with the highest attendance for week ending 1<sup>st</sup> March were:
