MMR VACCINATION WALK-IN CLINICS

There has been a recent Measles outbreak in Cardiff, and there are current outbreaks elsewhere in the UK.

Measles is highly contagious and can cause serious illness. The best way to protect your child is to ensure they are up to date with their MMR vaccines
