This term, the children have thoroughly enjoyed their learning across the topic, "Crack the Code. The children have been curious, they have been engineers and investigators and have shown increasing confidence in living in a digital world. Please see below a school showcase celebrating the learning that has taken place.



In Dosbarth 1 this term we have been practising planning routes inside and outside, following and giving instructions and we have learnt how to programme the Bee-Bots. We have had lots of fun finding out about robots! We have painted and printed robots and we have made them using construction and loose parts.

Dosbarth 2 have had lots of fun learning about robots. First, we read the story 'Robot Rumpus' and designed adverts for our very own robots which we have made into a class book. We used components to build circuits and we were able to make a bulb light up. We also worked together to design robot heads and made them by upcycling cardboard cereal boxes. Our robots had to have a light up nose and we used our knowledge of circuits to make this happen. We have had a very busy term!





Dosbarth 3 have been working with our new robot called mTiny. We have been using block coding to make it move, make it sing and even make it write and draw pictures! If only they could code the robot to make Mr Nicholls a cup of coffee! It has been lovely to see the children so engaged and excited about improving their digital skills whilst completing this 'unplugged' activity.



Dosbarth 4 tuned up and plugged into some great tunes this term as part of Cracking the Code. We met Ralph the Rusty Robot, found out about his story and sang his troubles. We also revisited our favourites autumn term like the country classics Freight Train and Midnight Train. Having a singing assembly every week has really progressed the vocal abilities of our young learners, who revel in opportunities to sing their hearts out.





Dosbarth 5 a 6 have thoroughly enjoyed working with our Lead Creative Practitioners on writing, producing and performing an album of songs. The children used their knowledge of Al and Robotics as a stimulus and used music to explore ideas around their futures - living and working with developing technology! It was great to see their confidence grow to the extent that they were able to perform their songs in front of the whole school! Da iawn chi!

Dosbarth 7, 8 a 9 have thoroughly enjoyed building and coding their own devices using the Lego Spike kits we have loaned from Cardiff Commitment this term. Within these sessions' pupils worked collaboratively and methodically to follow instructions, build code and debug any necessary issues they found with their devices.
