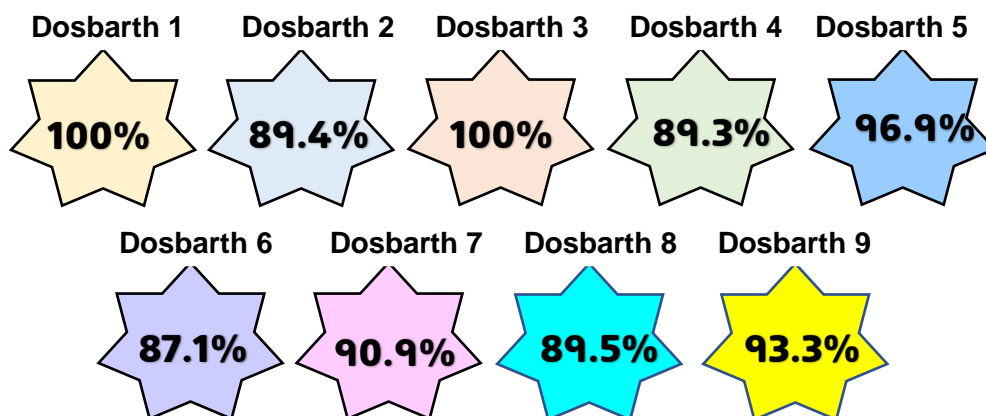

Learning Across the Curriculum

This term, our curriculum focus is called “Here we are – Dyma Ni!” We will be exploring the concepts of identify and belonging.

When looking at identify, the children will explore “who they are” They will understand that having an identity can give you a sense of belonging, which is important to their wellbeing and confidence. The children will also reflect on “Cynefin”, a welsh term defined by Curriculum for Wales as ‘the place where we feel we belong, where the people and landscape around us are familiar, and the sights and sounds are reassuringly recognisable.’

The progression across the school will involve looking at Canton, Cardiff, Wales and Countries around the world who have seen settlers from Wales. As part of this learning journey, the children will be provided with a wide range of experiences to celebrate their community.

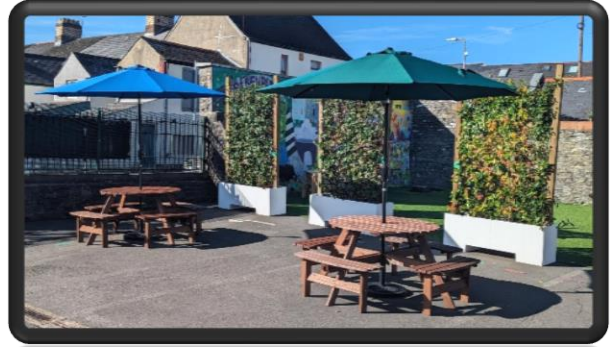
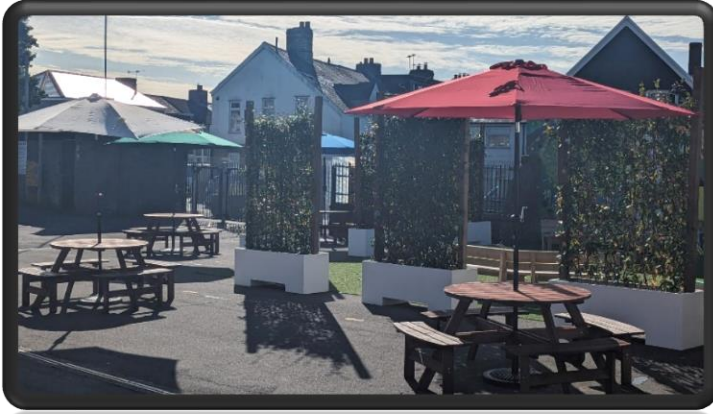
