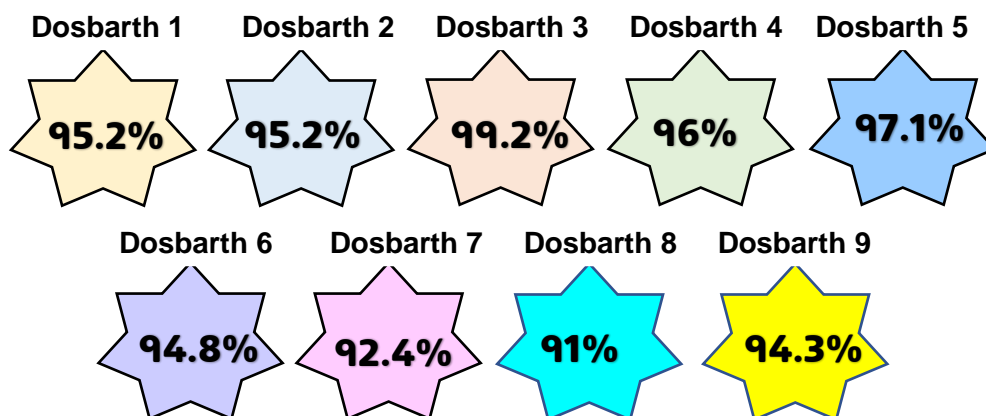

## Year 6 Transition to High School

The online application service will be available from **MONDAY, 23 SEPTEMBER 2024** which will be available at [www.cardiff.gov.uk/schooladmissions](http://www.cardiff.gov.uk/schooladmissions).

Online is the preferred method for applying for school places and provides the swiftest communication of the outcome of the application to parents on offer day. Details of how parents can receive support in submitting online applications are provided in the above information.

**If you need support in completing the online application, please contact the school office and we will do our very best to assist you. Assistance will also be available at Council advice hubs.**

Online applications and preference forms must be submitted by **no later than Monday, 18 November 2024**. Only applications received by this date will be considered in the initial round of allocation of places. Applications received after the closing date will be considered as late applications. It is therefore most important that parents are strongly encouraged to return the form on time because if all places are allocated in the initial round it may not be possible for the Council to approve a late application to a Community school.
