To purchase tickets, you will need to send a note in an envelope with your child requesting the date, time and number of tickets alongside the correct money.

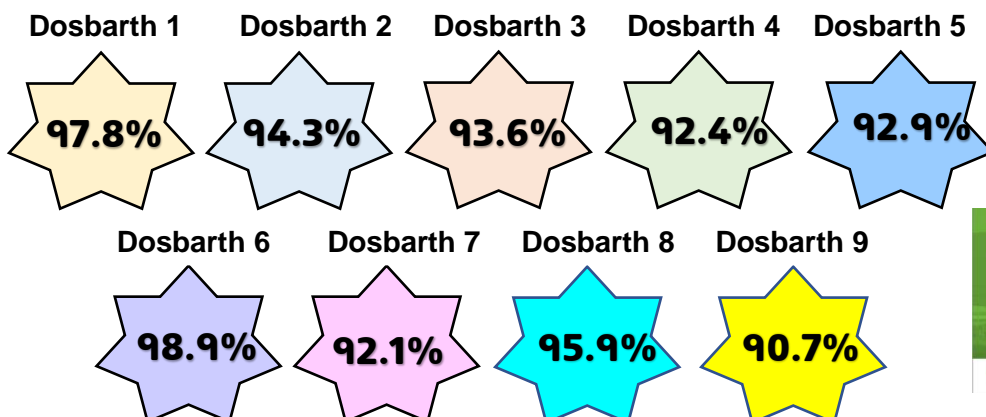
The last day to purchase tickets will be Monday 2nd December.

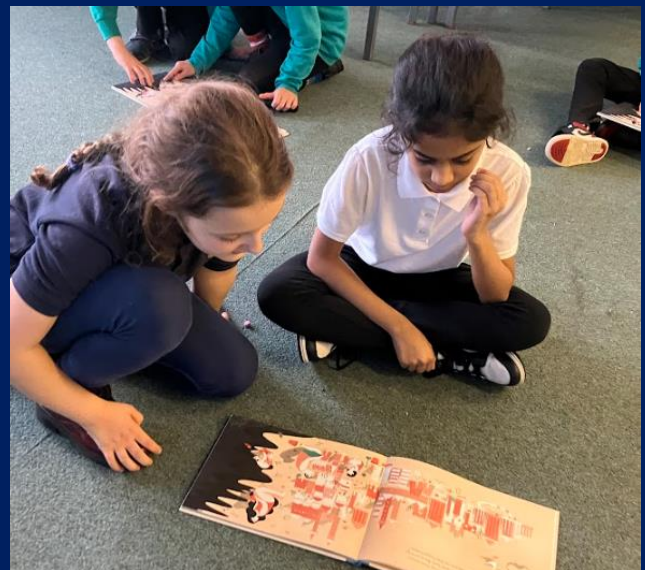
Spark Film Company
