### I will:

- Explore and compare mass and capacity
- Explore and compare length and height
- Explore 3D shapes

### Y1

#### I will:

- Investigate 2D and 3D shapes
- Investigate place value within 20 then within 50
- Investigate addition/ subtraction within 20
- Investigate length/ height
- Investigate mass/ volume

#### I can:

- Explore 2D and 3D shapes and their properties
- Understand that the value of a number can be determined by the position of the digits
- Estimate and measure using non-standard units before progressing onto standard units

## Health and Wellbeing

### I will:

- Investigate a range of Welsh foods
- Follow recipes to make a range of Welsh foods
- Understand what foods our bodies need to stay healthy and that some foods are treats
- Participate in a range of PE and games activities

### I can:
