Community Governor Vacancy

We currently have 1 community governor vacancy.

Community governors are part of the governing body of maintained schools (except voluntary-aided schools). Their appointment is governed by the Government of Maintained Schools (Wales) Regulations 2005 and the school's Instrument of Government.

Here's how the process works:

Who appoints them?

Community governors are appointed by the governing body itself, not elected.

They are chosen to represent the wider community and bring skills or experience that benefit the school. They do not need to have a child at the school.

Eligibility

They must not be employed at the school or be an elected member of the local authority that maintains the school.

They should ideally reflect the local community and support the school's ethos.

Term of Office

The standard term is 4 years

Role

Community governors have the same rights and responsibilities as other governors: setting strategic direction, monitoring performance, and ensuring accountability.

They act in the best interests of the school, not as representatives of any group

If you know anyone who is interested in being a community governor for the school, please ask them to contact the school office to discuss this further and before Thursday 12th March. We are hoping to appoint the community governor in our next meeting on 18th March 2026.
