Autism/Social Communication provision at Radnor 2026/2027

The consultation period for establishing a new 30 place Autism/Social Communication Specialist Resource Base at Radnor Primary School from January 2027 within the existing buildings began on 9th February 2026 and will end on 26th March 2026.

Consultation with staff took place this week and consultation with Governors and a group of learners will be completed by the end of next week.
