Eco Eisteddfod

For their learning this term, the children will be taking part in purposeful work and authentic learning opportunities in the lead-up to our school Eisteddfod, taking place on 27th March.

The focus for this work will be on:

1. Gaining an understanding of the importance of recycling.
2. Being proud of Wales' good work in this area.
3. Using the Eisteddfod as a platform to showcase learning.
4. Applying their numeracy and literacy skills across the curriculum.



All learning will be completed through the ends of Environment and Sustainability and the main areas for learning development will be Science and Technology and Expressive Arts.
