Uniform Consultation for September 2027

The children who make up Y Senedd Radnor would like to review the school uniform at Radnor Primary School to consider the introduction of a new school logo, a potential new uniform colour and to consider the implementation of coloured t-shirts, reflecting their house as part of the P.E kit. The changes would not be imminent and would likely be introduced from September 2027 onwards.

As part of this consultation, we will ensure any changes continue to support our values, reflects our community, and meets the practical needs of our pupils and families.

In line with Welsh Government statutory guidance, we must consider equality, cost, practicality, and the views of parents, pupils, and the wider community. The guidance highlights the importance of ensuring uniforms are affordable, accessible, inclusive of all genders, suitable for different cultural and religious backgrounds, and flexible enough to account for practical considerations such as weather and individual needs.

We are now seeking parental views as part of our consultation on the current school uniform. Your feedback will help us identify any changes we may wish to explore for the future.

Tuga in Dosbarth Glas.

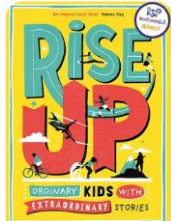
For being a remarkable football player.

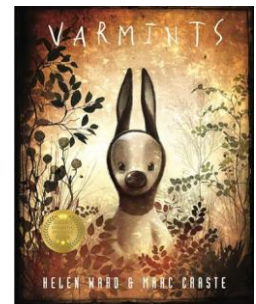

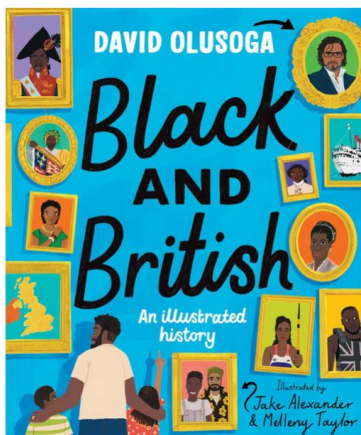

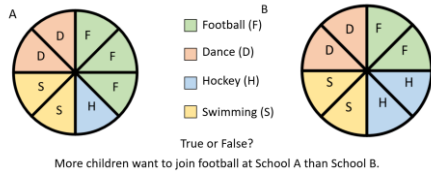


We also explored using drama for oracy - freeze frames and conscience alley worked really well for helping us to prepare for our writing.

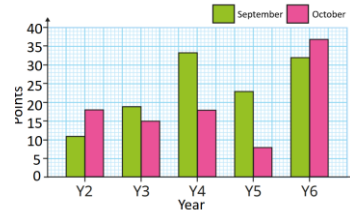


Our recent maths focus has based around data handling, fractions and decimal place value. We have been consolidating skills and applying them to real life situations.

At school A, 64 children were asked what sports team they would like to join. At school B, 96 children were asked what sports team they would like to join.

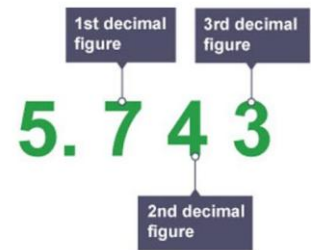


The dual bar chart shows the number of house points scored in September and October across Y2 - 6



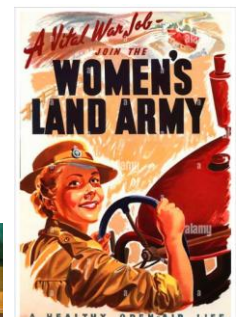
What questions could you ask your partner about this chart?

Decimal places are counted from the decimal point:

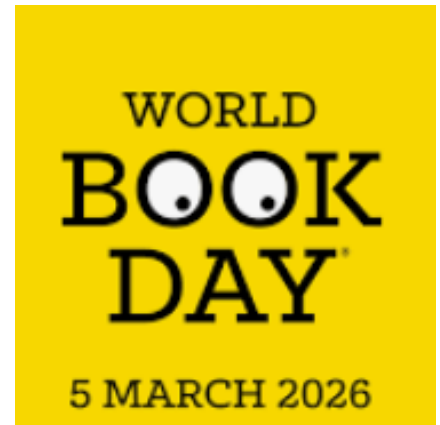


We enjoy using Blooket and other online games to support consolidation of our skills - plus, they're fun!

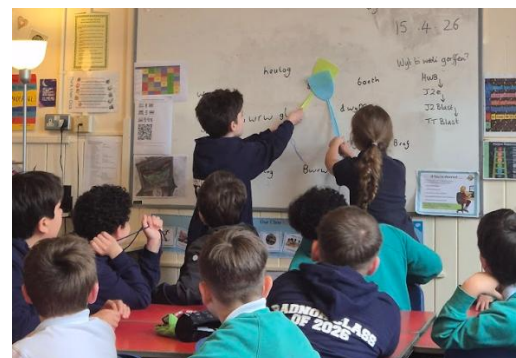


We really enjoy our Cymraeg Pob Dydd sessions - playing games and activities to improve and reinforce our use of Welsh language.

We've been working on talking about the weather in future tense - sut fydd y tywydd?

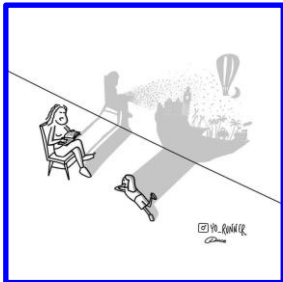
