Specialist Resource Base (SRB) Update - May 2026

I wanted to share a quick update with you about the progress of our Specialist Resource Base (SRB). When I last wrote to you in March, I explained that the work was due to start on 1st June. Since then, and due to the nature and timescales of the project, the Local Authority has confirmed that work now needs to begin earlier, from Monday 11th May.

After talking things through with staff, we decided to make the most of the INSET day on Friday 1st May to move Dosbarth Enfys, Dosbarth Coch and Dosbarth Oren into the main school building.

This has allowed us to plan carefully and avoid any unexpected closure days.

I cannot thank the staff enough — they have been fantastic, pulling together to make the move as smooth and positive as possible for the children. The children have settled extremely well into their new learning environments.



Because of all this work behind the scenes, we are now fully ready for contractors to be on site from Monday 11th May which will be pivotal in the base being ready to welcome new children in September.

As part of the move, there has been a small change to routines as follows:

- The collection point for Dosbarth Enfys, Coch and Oren has moved to the large double gate on Pembroke Road.
- Playworks after school club will run from the main hall. There are no changes to collection times or arrangements,

To support Dosbarth Enfys, Coch and Oren in continuing to have access to outdoor learning, a removal team will be on site on Saturday to relocate outdoor play equipment so it is easily.

Thank you, as always, for your continued support and understanding.

As we prepare for the SRB to open in September, we want to reassure you that we are deeply committed, passionate and genuinely excited about this development. We really do see the SRB as a wonderful opportunity to strengthen our inclusive ethos and ensure that every child — whether in the SRB or mainstream — is supported to thrive.

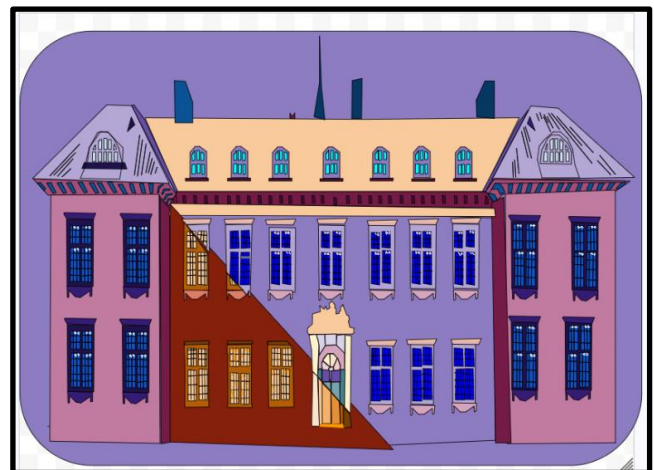
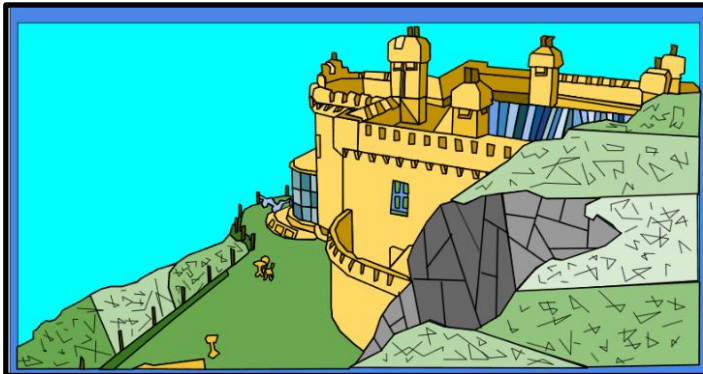
We were lucky to perform at Conway Church, which gave us an amazing backdrop.
