Parking Outside the School

We have recently noticed an increase in vehicles stopping or parking on the zig zag lines outside the school. As part of the uniform consultation and following all classes being based in the main school building, we have reviewed the current arrangements we have in place regarding children wearing and/or changing into their P.E kits.

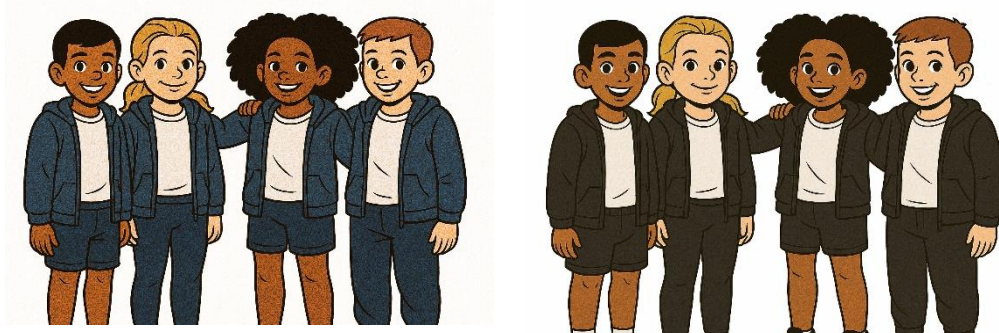
For Summer Term 2, we are going to trial the children wearing P.E kits into school on the days they have P.E and remaining in their P.E kit for the day.

We are studying this topic through the lens of **Technology**, with a particular focus on **Science and Technology and Humanities**.

Across the school, learners will explore how ideas are tested, improved and applied in real-world contexts. There will be a strong focus on **problem-solving, critical thinking, sustainability, and ethical decision-making**, helping children to understand their role in shaping the future.

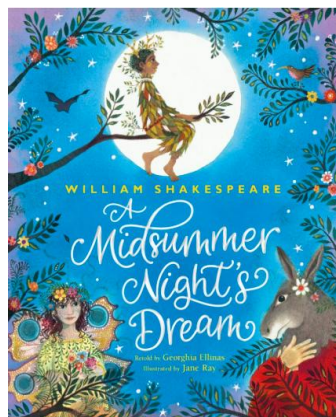

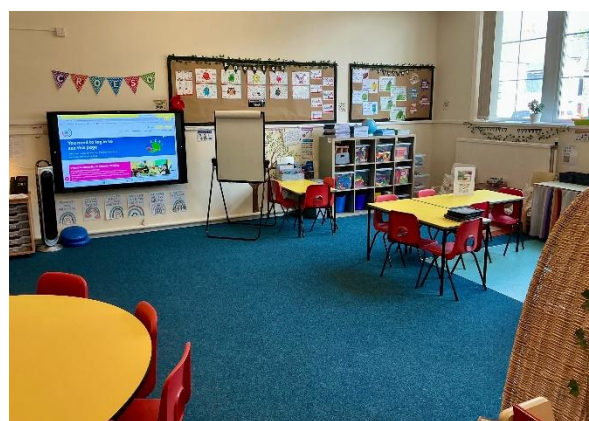
